# Year 7 moving to HS 2022

If your child is currently in Year 3 in 2018 they will be amongst the first cohort of children in South Australia moving to Year 7 in a high School environment in 2022.

It has been confirmed by the Education Department that year 7s will move as a single cohort in term 1, 2022, however discussions are underway as to whether there will be a small pilot program in advance of that start date, with a small number of schools.

This shift will provide year 7 students with access to dedicated facilities and resources, and exposure to different teaching styles that will give each student opportunities for deeper learning, greater peer interactions, and greater independence and responsibility.

We will continue to share updates from the Department for Education as they are provided to us.
