## Goal: Improve student achievement levels by using assessment to track growth, inform planning and deliver intentional teaching

**2018 Goal**: Develop and implement whole <u>school systems</u> that use data to <u>track student growth</u> with a focus on one year's growth and enables setting targets for individual students just below SEA and those in Upper Bands.

Literacy	PLCs develop processes to analyse student achievement data to set targets and plan teaching.
